Drug and Alcohol misuse







When and how we can support you.




We are here to help you in Custody every day of the week between 0700 -1900, and in court Monday to Saturday.



Outside of custody and court the team is available Monday to Friday 0900-1700



Sometimes the support we give is over the phone.



Otherwise, we will meet you in person.



The team is made up of different people that can help in different ways.

In custody and court, you will see:

- Nurses
- Support workers



These people can help identify any problems you might have.

In the community you will see:

- Support workers
- Peer Support work



These people can help you to sort out the problems you might have.







